RSV Vaccines

RSV vaccine is available for pregnant ladies who are 28-32 weeks pregnant and also those turning 75 years with a catch up of 75-79 year olds. RSV causes most cases of bronchiolitis (breathing problems) in infants, and in the elderly can be as severe as flu leading to hospital admissions and mortalities every year. This one off vaccine offers protection to the new-born via the Mum and to the elderly.

North Solihull Primary Care Network (PCN) consists of a group of 10 general practices in North Solihull who have agreed to work together to improve services for patients living in this area. We work alongside a range of local providers across primary care, community services, social care and the voluntary sector, to offer more personalised, coordinated health and social care to their local populations.

In addition, the PCN can recruit a more diverse skill mix into general practice through recruitment of roles such as pharmacists, first contact physiotherapists, social prescribers, paramedics and physician associates.

You may be offered an appointment with one of the above at the Practice.

North Solihull PCN is the largest single PCN in the Birmingham and Solihull area. We have 10 GP practices and 4 branch sites with a total population of 77,248.

Megan is our Clinical Pharmacist who supports patients and the surgery with the following:

She can help by:

- Reviewing your medicines.
- Agreeing and making changes to your prescriptions.
- Advising about medicines and possible side effects.

Social Prescribing

The Social Prescribing Service provides a link/intervention support to help improve the health and well-being of patients. Once the patient is referred, The Link Worker will contact the patient and talk through the referral to discuss what matters to them and support the patient with the next stages of support.

The Service provides support in many different areas such as benefits, food bank access, domestic abuse relationships, social isolation, housing (where we can help), community group access, recently arrived in the UK, low reported well-being, poor management of long-term conditions, substance misuse, financial hardship, Food/bank assistance.

If you think this could be helpful to you, please contact the surgery and we can arrange a referral for you.
